## PRESS RELEASE February 2, 2022

The Community Foundation of Carroll County ("CFCC") is pleased to announce the award of twenty-one grants from the County Endowment program, the CFCC Endowment Fund, and the Grow Greene County Gaming Corporation County Grants, including the fifth and last year of a multi-year pledge to the Carroll Public Library Foundation and the third year of a three-year pledge to the St. Anthony Foundation for its Cancer Center. The award determinations were made at the CFCC's Annual Meeting held on Monday, January 31, 2022. To date, **\$1,625,510.72** has been granted by the CFCC for the benefit Carroll County residents.

This year, the CFCC made grants totaling \$188,637.27. \$109,074.75 was distributed from the County Endowment program and \$30,862.52 from the CFCC's Endowment Fund, and \$53,700.00 from a grant from the Grow Greene County Gaming Corporation. \$5,000 from the County Endowment went to the CFCC for administrative purposes.
