The Community Foundation of Carroll County (“CFCC”) is pleased to announce the award of twenty grants from the County Endowment program, the CFCC Endowment Fund, and the Grow Greene County Gaming Corporation County Grants. The award determinations were made at the CFCC’s Annual Meeting held on Thursday, February 2, 2023. To date, **\$1,814,258.99** has been granted by the CFCC for the benefit Carroll County residents.

This year, the CFCC made grants and distributions totaling \$197,502.50. \$115,502.50 will be distributed from the County Endowment program, \$25,000.00 from the CFCC’s Endowment Fund, and \$52,000.00 from a grant from the Grow Greene County Gaming Corporation. \$5,000 from the County Endowment program will go to the CFCC for administrative purposes. Grant funds will be distributed as follows for the County Endowment and the CFCC Endowment Fund grants:
